TRANSFERRING PERSONAL DATA OVERSEAS

YOUR RIGHTS

RIGHT	DETAIL
Marketing – You have a right to object to direct marketing.	You have a right to object to processing of your personal information for direct marketing purposes.
Rectification – You have a right to rectification of inaccurate personal information and to update incomplete personal information.	If you believe that any of the information that we hold about you is inaccurate, you have a right to request that we restrict the processing of that information and to rectify the inaccurate personal information.
Erasure – You have a right to request that we delete your personal information.	You may request that we delete your personal information if you believe that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> we no longer need to process your information for the purposes for which it was provided; we have requested your permission to process your personal information and you wish to withdraw your consent;

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • we are not using your information in a lawful manner; or • you have objected to your data being processed.
Restriction – You have a right to request us to restrict the processing of your personal information.	<p>You may request us to restrict processing your personal information if you believe that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • any of the information that we hold about you is inaccurate; • we no longer need to process your information for the purposes for which it was provided, but you require the information to establish, exercise or defend legal claims; or • we are not using your information in a lawful manner.
Objection – You have a right to object to the processing of your personal information.	<p>You have a right to object to us processing your personal information, including the profiling of your information (and to request us to restrict processing). We may override this request where:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • we determine that there is a compelling and legitimate grounds for the processing; • we need to process your information to investigate and protect us or others from legal claims.
Portability – You have a right to data portability.	<p>You may request us to transfer to a third-party your data in a machine-readable format where the:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • personal information was provided on the basis of consent; • processing is by automated means; and • processing is based on the fulfilment of a contractual obligation.
Withdraw consent – You have a right to withdraw your consent.	<p>Where we rely on your consent to process your personal information for a particular purpose, you have a right to withdraw your consent at any time for that purpose.</p>
